



NORTH BROADWAY (US 27) ROADWAY IMPROVEMENTS AND RAILROAD BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

WELCOME

The purpose of tonight's meeting is to inform the public of the improvements to North Broadway (US 27) under the L&N (RJ Corman) railroad bridge. This is an informational meeting with no formal presentation. Located through the room are displays with general information regarding future improvements to roadway and railroad. Representatives from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet and their consultants (Strand, WMB, and EHI), are available tonight to answer questions you may have concerning these improvements. Please feel free to locate one of these representatives (designated with a nametag) to direct your questions.

7-412 IMPROVEMENTS

The project reconstructs North Broadway from Northland Drive to New Circle Road. The roadway reconstruction requires the railroad bridge to be permanently relocated to the south, which allows the new bridge to be constructed adjacent to the existing bridge while the railroad remains open to traffic. The reconstruction will include:

- Widened roadway typical section (44 feet to 83 feet) to improve the horizontal clearance, provide a left turn lane from Broadview Drive to New Circle Road, and a dedicated bicycle/pedestrian facility.
- Increased vertical clearance to provide access for larger vehicles that are currently restricted.
- Improved drainage infrastructure along North Broadway and New Circle Road to address the flooding that currently causes the roadway to be closed during heavy rain events.
