The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) will hold a virtual public meeting from 6 – 7 p.m. Thursday, Jan. 27, 2022 to discuss the Panbowl Lake dam in Jackson. A detailed engineering analysis of the dam is nearly complete following last year's historic flooding in Breathitt County.

In the wake of the historic flood, KYTC officials and engineering consultants evaluated the condition of the embankments and conducted a hydrologic and hydraulic study of Panbowl Lake.

The public meeting will be conducted online via a Zoom, beginning with a presentation from KYTC representatives and concluding with an opportunity to ask questions. Attendees will be required to register for the event in advance at bit.ly/panbowl-meeting. After registering, attendees will receive an email with instructions for accessing the meeting. Due to concerns related to COVID-19, an in-person public meeting will not be held.
