12/1/16 I-65 16 mp \$B food grade polyethylene / parrifin wax coating

Spills < EM Reportable Qty

- Spills 2 25 gal gasoline, 75 gal diesel, 125 gal oil cleanup or other hazmat require KYEM, mandate mitigation, responsible party payment.
- Hazmat spills under reportable quantity are gray area, no ability to compel responsible party to cleanup.
- Larger spills of non-haz or minimal haz materials.


4/14/17 Crash @ I-65 26 SB


- Friday night, heavy traffic, bottom of 26 SB entrance ramp
- 1 fatality, several injuries at least one critical w/ scene helo evac.
- 2 h 40 m SB closure for response, investigation, and cleanup.
- Traffic queue from 26 to north of 28 within 15 minutes.
- Response:
 - Diversion off at 28 SB
 - Clearance of queue via Exit 26


Diversion & queue clearance started by BGPD then assumed by KYTC approximately 1 into event.

4/14/17 Crash @ I-65 26 SB

- Lessons learned or reinforced
 - Confirmed previous decision to abandon old plan for 22-28
 - Utilize nearest exits for queue clearance only
 - Integrate new Exit 30 / KY3145 when initial segment is opened (late July).
 - Some people will self-detour, we cannot prevent this, only provide primary route with directional help.
 - High priority is in advance communication via overhead DMS at the 32 SB and/or 17 NB to get traffic to detour route as early as possible in incident.
 - Rely more heavily on permanent wayfinding signs rather than detour signs that require deployment during incident.

 Commonwealth has a Master Agreement w/ special pricing 30-50% off catalog price




