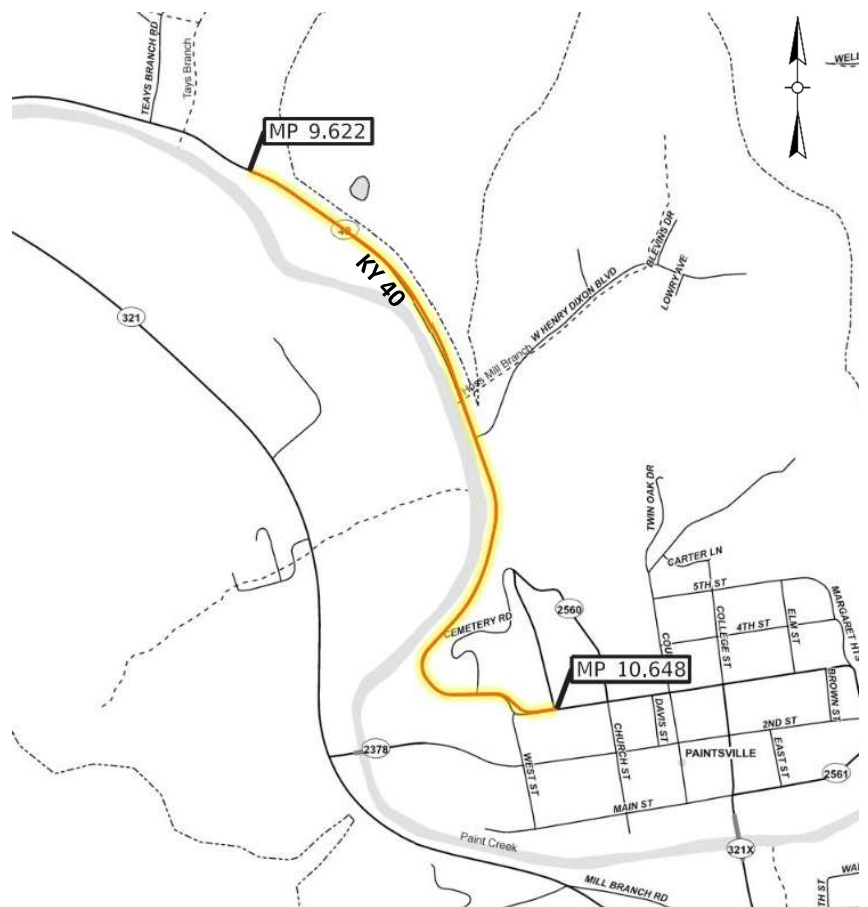
The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) with STV, Inc. has developed preliminary design plans for KY 40. The purpose of the project (Item No. 12-149.00) is to improve roadway geometrics and increase capacity on KY 40 from Garbage Hollow to East of Mill Street.

The project improves the existing KY 40 route with numerous geometric improvements, including a redesign of the intersection of KY 40 and West Street. Several features proposed to the corridor would include 4-foot-wide paved shoulders, a designated turn lane at William Henry Dixon Blvd., a retaining wall limiting impacts to Paint Creek, and near the Hospital a modern curb-and-gutter section with sidewalk.

The project is currently in the design phase and definitive impacts have yet been determined. Exhibits show preliminary estimated impacts and are subject to change.
