Curbside Sorting Tips

MORE MANAGEABLE

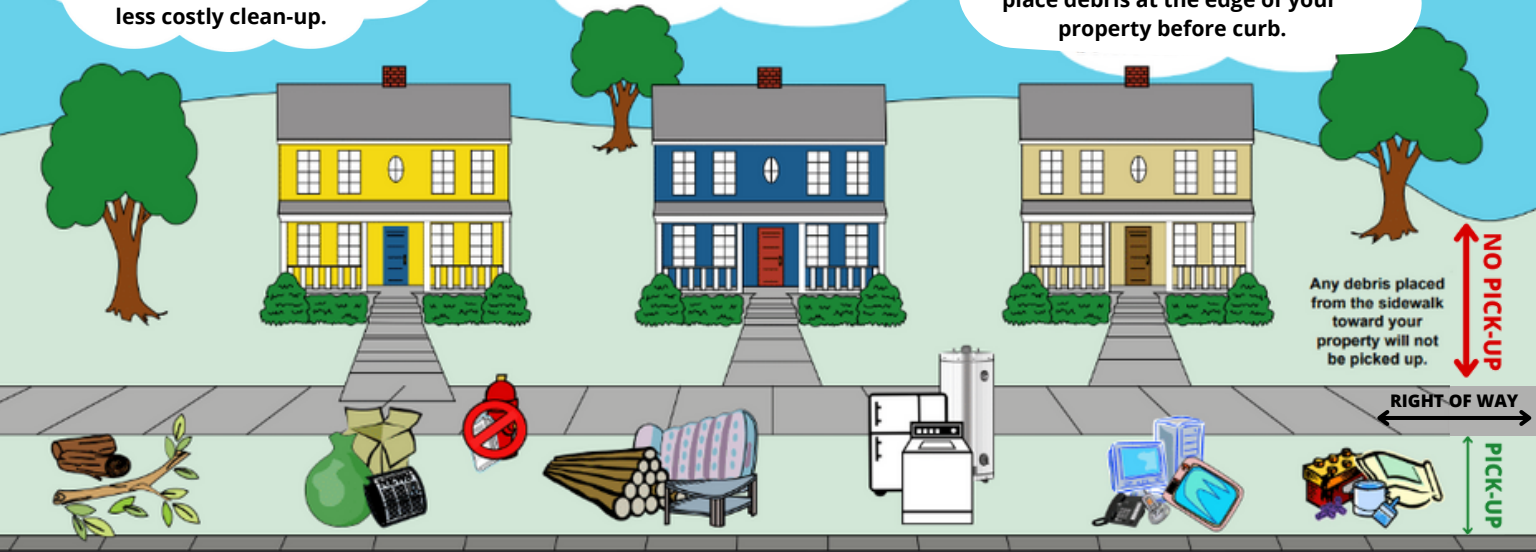
Follow these guidelines when putting out your debris to make for a speedier and less costly clean-up.

DO NOT STACK DEBRIS AGAINST

Trees poles, fire hydrants, and storm drains.

NO SIDEWALK

If you do not have a sidewalk, place debris at the edge of your property before curb.



Any debris placed from the sidewalk toward your property will not be picked up.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW)

- Oils
- Batteries
- Pesticides
- Oil-based Paints and Stains
- Cleaning Supplies
- Lawn Chemicals
- Compressed Gas

SPOILED FOOD CONTAMINATED RECYCLBLES

- Unusable food items
- Wet or mildewed newspaper, card board, other

NOTE: Normal household trash will not be picked up with debris

STRUCTURAL DEBRIS BULKY WASTE

- Building materials
- Drywall
- Lumber
- Carpet
- Furniture
- Mattresses
- Plumbing

APPLIANCES

- Refrigerators (remove all food & secure the doors)
- Washers, Dryers
- Freezers
- Air Conditioners
- Stoves
- Water Heaters
- Dishwashers

ELECTONICS

- Televisions
- Computers
- Radios
- Stereos
- Telephones
- Other Devices

VEGETATION DEBRIS

- Tree Branches
- Leaves
- logs
