

DOWNED POWER LINE ON THE ROADWAY?

 **Never touch or drive over a fallen power line.**

Report the issue to the power company.

 **Do not drive through standing water.**
If downed lines are in the water.

 **Stay inside the vehicle.**
If a line has fallen on your car; the ground may be energized. Sound the horn, call for help, then call 9-1-1.

 **Assume all downed power lines are live.**
And do not attempt to move one, even with non-conductive materials like wood or cloth.



TRAFFIC SIGNAL NOT WORKING?

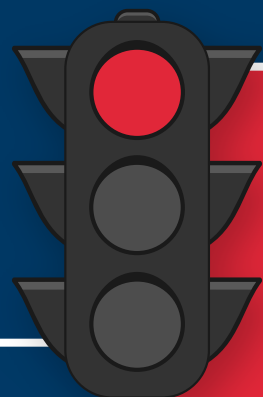
FLASHING YELLOW? PROCEED WITH CAUTION.

When a traffic signal is blinking yellow, proceed through the signaled intersection with caution when traffic permits.



FLASHING RED? TREAT AS A STOP SIGN.

When a traffic signal is blinking red, treat the signaled intersection like a stop sign.



NO SIGNAL LIGHTS? TREAT AS A 4-WAY STOP.

When a traffic signal is out, treat the signaled intersection like a 4-way stop sign.



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
