What You Need to Know

Six new roundabouts are being built in Henderson. There will be three located at the reconstructed KY 351/2nd Street interchange and three roundabouts located at the new US 60 interchange.

The first two roundabouts at KY 351/2nd Street are located west of US 41 and are expected to open to traffic in late summer 2024.

Benefits of a Roundabout

Using a Roundabout

A roundabout is an unsignalized one-way circular intersection that improves traffic flow, minimizes congestion, and increases safety.

Roundabouts are used to promote lower speeds and reduce conflict points, leading to improved performance.

ROUNDABOUTS: WHAT TO EXPECT



- Two western roundabouts (closest to North Middle School) open to one lane of traffic
- Open in temporary configuration
- Open to one lane of traffic





ROUNDABOUTS: WHAT TO EXPECT




- Offers a good chance for people to get used to driving roundabouts
- Helps facilitate traffic movement and flow in the area
- Ramps to and from US 41 open
- Temporary signals no longer in use



ROUNDABOUTS: WHAT TO EXPECT




- The third roundabout won't function as a roundabout until late this year.
- It won't open until the new ramps to and from US 41 North are complete.
- Drivers will continue to use the existing on and off ramps to access US 41.








PEDESTRIAN ACCESS





Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB) to be installed at all crossings.



PEDESTRIAN ACCESS



- Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFB) will be installed at all pedestrian crossings.
- "Push to Cross" buttons remain in place at Klutey Park and should be used by all crossing the road.

A crossing guard was present near KY 2084 for the first 2 weeks as students adjusted to the new roundabouts and pedestrian patterns.



PROGRESS BY THE NUMBERS







- Embankment placed: Over 1 million cubic yards
- Structural concrete poured: Over
 6,500 cubic yards
- Reinforcing steel installed: Nearly 1.3 million pounds
- H-Pile installed to date: 22,000 linear feet

Over 225,000 hours have been worked on the project.
