## Socioeconomic and Demographic Characteristics

The tables shown in this appendix have been excerpted from Section 2.4 of the "Socioeconomic Analysis" (August 2012) prepared for the KY 32 project. The report is summarized in Section 3.3 of this "Environmental Assessment (EA)." The full report is on file with KYTC.

The following tables summarize the trends and status of the socioeconomic and demographic characteristics for the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Rowan County, Elliott County, and the proposed project's study area, as recorded in the 2010 Census (see *Environmental Assessment*, Figure 3, "Socioeconomic Study Area"). The study area includes two census tracts and three block groups: Census Tract 9504, Block Group 3 in Rowan County, and Census Tract 9201, Block Groups 2 and 3 in Elliott County. The three Census Block Groups containing the proposed project right-of-way were examined, and are collectively referred to as the "Socioeconomic Study Area."
