Dear Mr. Waldner:

The Kentucky Heritage Council has received for review and comment the above referenced Determination of Effects Report completed by QK4 and the URS Corporation. A previous Determination of Eligibility Report was commented on by this office on January 13, 2012. In those comments, we concurred that the following sites were either eligible for or listed in the National Register of Historic Places: RW-15, RW-190, EL-26, EL-32, EL-38, and EL-51. In addition, we now concur with the following determinations of effect recommended by the FHWA as well:

Alternative 1A: No Effect to RW-15, RW-190, EL-32, EL-38, and EL-51 and Adverse Effect to EL-26.

Alternative 1B: No Effect to RW-15, RW-190, EL-32, EL-38, and EL-51 and No Adverse Effect to EL-26.

Alternative 2A: No Effect to RW-15, RW-190, EL-32, EL-38, and EL-51 and No Adverse Effect to EL-26.

Alternative 3: No Effect to RW-15, RW-190, EL-26, EL-32, EL-38, and EL-51 and No Adverse Effect to EL-26 and EL-38.

Thank you for coordinating with this office. We look forward to continued consultation under the Resolution of Adverse Effects phase should Alternative 1A be selected as the preferred. If you have any questions please contact Craig Potts of my staff at (502) 564-7005, ext. 123.
