The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has scheduled a public informational meeting regarding the widening of US 60 south of Ashland between I-64 and the US 60/KY 180 intersection at Cannonsburg consisting of four driving lanes with shoulders. The meeting will follow an open house format with a project overview at 5:15 p.m. and 6:15 p.m. Maps of the alternatives being considered will be available. Information and comments gathered will be considered as the design progresses.

During the meeting, individuals will be able to view displays and ask questions one on one with Department representatives. A questionnaire/comment sheet will be distributed facilitating public comment. Oral and written comments can be made during and after the meeting, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. local time until June 7, 2012 at the Department of Highways District 9 Office, located at 822 Elizaville Avenue in Flemingsburg, P. O. Box 347, Kentucky 41041. The materials presented during the meeting will also be made available at that location during the same time period.

All oral and written comments will become part of the official meeting record. Once compiled, the meeting record and other supporting documentation will be made available for review and copying only after an Open Records Request has been received and approved. All Open Records Requests must be submitted to the Transportation Cabinet, Office of Legal Affairs, Transportation Office Building, 200 Mero Street, Frankfort, Kentucky 40622.

Information concerning Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act will be available for anyone interested in signing up for this important process.
