The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) will conduct a Virtual Public Hearing from 6 p.m. to 7 p.m., CST, on Tuesday, March 9, 2021. If desired, In-Person, By-Appointment Public Hearing sessions will be scheduled following the virtual component. These public hearings are to receive comments on the Environmental Assessment (EA) for the U.S. 60 Project. The objective of this project is to improve safety and mobility along the U.S. 60 corridor near Kevil. Those wishing to attend the virtual public hearing are encouraged to register on the project website. Upon registering, attendees will receive an email with meeting instructions and information for attending.

KYTC representatives will be available during the Virtual Public Hearing to discuss information presented and to answer questions. Please note that you must register for the virtual public hearing to make a public statement. Those wishing to make a public statement may register to do so by calling (502) 892-6044 or by emailing US60Ballard@qk4.com. Public statements will be limited to 3 minutes each.

Attendees at the virtual public hearing will have the opportunity to review the alternatives studied, the preferred alternative, the Environmental Assessment, and to provide comments for consideration by KYTC as the project further develops. All information is available for review online and will remain accessible for at least 15 days following the date of the last inperson, by-appointment public hearing session. The same information will be presented at both the virtual and in-person sessions; it is not necessary to attend multiple meetings.

Comments submitted online or by mail will be accepted through March 31, 2021.



Those wishing to schedule an in-person, by-appointment public hearing session should call (502) 892-6044. Sessions will be scheduled as soon as possible after the virtual hearing, contingent upon the latest COVID-19 health and safety guidelines.

Adherence to current State and Federal COVID-19 meeting guidelines will be strictly followed. Each 60-minute in-person, by-appointment session is limited to 8 persons from the public and 2 KYTC representatives. Additional information regarding meeting attendance will be provided following individual session requests.

Displays illustrating the alternatives studied and the preferred alternative are presented on the project website and will be discussed at the virtual meeting. The Environmental Assessment can also be reviewed on the project website. The virtual public hearing and subsequent in-person, by-appointment sessions will present the same information. Following the presentation, KYTC will then hear and respond to questions from attendees who, prior to the meeting, registered to speak during the meeting as described above. A recording of the virtual public hearing and a transcript of all comments will be posted to the project website at the conclusion of the comment period. Written comments may be submitted as described above.
