The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has scheduled a public meeting for the proposed safety improvement project of KY-36 from the eastbound on and off ramps of I-64 to the KY-965 (Hart Pike) intersection. This meeting will be open house format, meaning that interested parties may attend any time from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM, Thursday, August 31, 2023, at the Bath County Fiscal Courthouse. There will be a brief 5-to-10-minute project overview presentation tentatively scheduled to start at 5:30 PM.

The purpose of this meeting is to gather information from the public and answer questions about the KY-36 roadway project. The goal of the KY-36 project is to provide a more consistent roadway by improving the existing roadway geometrics, widening the driving lanes/shoulders, and improving intersection sight distance where applicable. Anyone having an interest in this project is welcome to attend. Transportation Cabinet representatives and their consultant, WSP will be available to receive comments and respond to questions. In addition, information concerning Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act will be available for any interested in signing up for this important process.

Both written and oral statements will be accepted at the meeting. A tape recorder will be made available for those who desire to make oral statements, and a comment sheet will be distributed to make it more convenient to provide written comments. Written statements will be accepted at the meeting and for a period of 15 days after the Public Information Meeting. Written statements should be addressed to Blake Jones, P.E., Kentucky Department of Highways, District 9 Office, P.O. Box 347, Flemingsburg, KY 41041, or returned using the postage-paid envelope provided with the comment sheet. All recorded and written statements will become part of the official record. Once compiled, the meeting record will be made available for review and copying after an Open Records Request has been received and approved. All Open Records Requests must be submitted to the Office of Legal Services, Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, 200 Mero Street, Transportation Office Building, Frankfort, Kentucky 40622.
