Transportation Cabinet to Hold Public Meeting Sept. 10 for KY 44 Improvements in Bullitt County

Public invited to review and comment on preliminary roadway designs

Louisville, Ky. (Aug. 22, 2024) - The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) will hold a public meeting Sept. 10 to inform residents and gather input on preliminary designs to improve safety and traffic flow along KY 44 in Bullitt County.

The meeting will be an open-house event held from 5 to 7 p.m. at Mt. Washington Elementary School, 9234 KY 44, Mt. Washington, Ky. Those who are interested may drop in any time to review preliminary designs, receive handouts containing project information, and fill out comment sheets. Representatives from KYTC and the engineering design consultant will be in attendance to answer questions.

The purpose of the project is to improve safety and accessibility along KY 44 from Water Street to U.S. 31E. Alternatives currently being considered include reconfiguring KY 44 to five lanes with a center turn lane, four lanes with a raised median, or converting the U.S. 31E intersection to a median U-turn crossing to improve signal times and traffic flow.

An [online survey](#) will be made available following the public meeting. The final design phase will take place after the consideration of public feedback.

All written comments will become part of the official meeting record. Once compiled, the meeting record and supporting documentation will be made available for review and copying only after an open records request has been received and approved. All open records requests must be submitted to the Transportation Cabinet, Office of Legal Services, Transportation Office Building (200 Metro St, Frankfort, KY 40622), or via kytc.openrecords@ky.gov.
