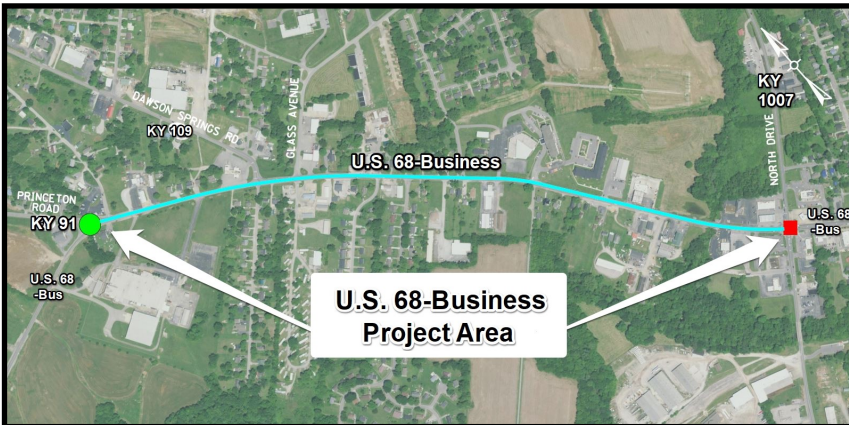


The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) has scheduled an informational meeting to **present plans for improving mobility and reducing congestion along U.S. 68-Business/West 7th Street in Hopkinsville between KY 91/Princeton Rd (milepoint 9.22) and KY 1007/North Drive (milepoint 10.13).** Anyone having an interest in this project is urged to attend.

The meeting will begin at 5:00 p.m., CDT, and end at approximately 7:00 p.m., CDT. Displays illustrating the proposed reconstruction of this section of U.S. 68-Business will be available. During the meeting, individuals will have the opportunity to review displays, ask questions, and discuss the project with Department of Highways engineers and staff, as well as consultants working on the project.

Displays and other materials presented at the Public Meeting also will be available for review at the KYTC District 2 Office at 1840 North Main Street in Madisonville for two weeks following the meeting. Office Hours for the District 2 Office are Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., CDT.
