The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) will host a public meeting at the former East Hardin Middle School cafeteria to present improvement concepts developed to improve mobility for the Glendale area. The meeting will be held in a hybrid format with identical content and input opportunities online and in-person.

The in-person meeting will follow an "open house" format where citizens may drop by anytime between the hours of 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM to speak to KYTC representatives, learn more about the study, and offer ideas on how to improve area transportation. There will be no formal presentation, but project team members will be on hand to answer questions.

For those preferring a virtual setting, a website at www.GlendaleStudy.com contains the same information that will be presented at the meeting. Citizens can view study information and complete a survey; responses will be collected through November 18. Written comments may also be submitted to KYTC District 4 personnel by email or mail through Nov. 18th. Comments received will be taken into consideration as the project continues.

Once compiled, the meeting record will be made available for review and copying only after an Open Records Request has been received and approved. All Open Records Requests must be submitted to the KYTC, Office of Legal Services, Transportation Cabinet Office Building, 200 Mero Street, Frankfort, Kentucky 40622.

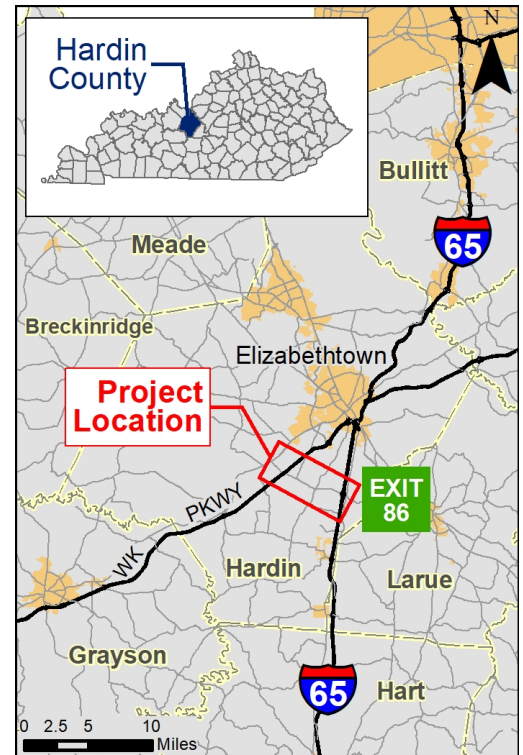
