The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) will hold a public meeting to inform citizens on the initial phase of the Outer Loop Transportation Study, which will identify short-term and long-term improvements for the roughly three-mile corridor on KY 1065 (Outer Loop) between Interstate 65 and KY 2052 (Shepherdsville Road).

During the upcoming meeting, KYTC will present data regarding the current traffic, safety, and environmental conditions along Outer Loop. KYTC is seeking community input on current conditions and concerns regarding the corridor.

The meeting will be conducted in an open house format (no formal presentation), allowing attendees to view various exhibits, talk to KYTC representatives and ask questions about the study.

Surveys will be available at the meeting for the public to provide written feedback directly to the project team. Additionally, the survey will be available online following the public meeting at: bit.ly/OuterLoopStudy. Surveys will be accepted online or via mail through Friday, Oct. 10, 2025. Paper copies of the survey should be mailed to the KYTC District 5 Office at 8310 Westport Road, Louisville, KY 40242.

Additionally, following the public meeting, displays and materials will be available for review through Oct. 10 at the KYTC District 5 Office in Louisville. Office hours are Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. EST.

All responses will become part of the official meeting record. Once compiled, the meeting record and supporting documentation will be made available for review and copying only after an Open Records Request has been received and approved. All Open Records Requests must be submitted to the Transportation Cabinet, Office of Legal Services, Transportation Office Building, 200 Metro St, Frankfort, KY 40622, or via kytc.openrecords@ky.gov.
