Manchester, KY – The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet is seeking public input regarding proposed improvements to KY 1487 in Barbourville, KY. The proposed project beings at Judge Street and runs to US 25E.

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has scheduled a Public Information Meeting, the purpose of the meeting is to introduce the proposed project to the public. The purpose of this project is to improve safety along KY 1487 which connects KY 6 and Union College to Barbourville's northmost connection to US 25E. Currently, KY 1487 between Judge Street and US 25E has narrow driving lanes which vary between 9 to 10 feet wide. Shoulders are minimal, leaving very little recovery area for motorists. Frequent flooding in the area makes the road impassable causing residents in the California Hollow Area to become trapped behind flood waters.

The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has scheduled a Public Information Meeting on **October 18th**, **2022**. The public meeting will run from **6:00 pm – 8:00 pm** in the **District Court Room** of the **Barbourville Court House** in Barbourville, Kentucky. Transportation Cabinet representatives will be available to receive comments and respond to questions. The meeting will be conducted in an open format, meaning that interested parties may attend at any point in the meeting's duration.

Both written and oral statements will be accepted at the meeting. A tape recorder will be made available for those who desire to make oral statements, and a comment sheet will be distributed to make it more convenient to provide written comments.

Written statements will be accepted at the meeting and for a period of 15 days after the Public Information Meeting. All recorded and written statements will become part of the official record.
