The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet (KYTC) has scheduled a Public Information Meeting to present plans for the proposed KY 11 reconstruction project in Lee County. The project corridor extends from approximately 0.5 mile south of the KY 587 intersection to approximately 0.65 mile north of KY 52 in Beattyville and is part of a larger corridor improvement extending from Interstate 75 to the Mountain Parkway.

The purpose of this meeting is to share project information with the public and gather written input during the design and environmental phase of development. The project is intended to improve safety, upgrade roadway geometrics, and enhance regional connectivity along the KY 11 corridor.

This meeting will be informal and held in an open-house format. No formal presentation will be given, and participants may attend at any time between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. Attendees will be able to review maps and displays, obtain project information, and discuss the proposed improvements with members of the project team. Handouts and written comment forms will be available at the meeting.

Written comments may be submitted at the meeting or by mail or email through February 19, 2026. All comments received will be reviewed and considered as the project continues through the design and environmental process. Right-of-way acquisition and construction schedules have not yet been established.
