The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has scheduled a public information meeting for the proposed spot improvements of US 119 between Whitesburg and Jenkins in Letcher County. The project begins on US 119 near the intersection with US 119 and KY 15 and ends near the intersection with US 119 and US 23 at Jenkins. The purpose of the meeting is to present the alternates currently under design. Those attending will be encouraged to provide feedback regarding the design. Anyone having an interest in this project is urged to attend.

The public meeting will take place from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. on Tuesday, February 20, 2018. Transportation Cabinet representatives will be available to receive comments and respond to questions. The meeting will be conducted in an open format, meaning that the interested parties may attend at any point in the meeting's duration.

Both written and oral statements will be accepted at the meeting. A recording device will be made available for those who desire to make oral statements and a comment sheet will be distributed to make it more convenient to provide written comments. Additionally, this meeting will provide the public an opportunity to voice concerns on potential impacts to a recreational trail within Fishpond Lake Park, a recreational property protected under Section 4(f) of the U.S. Department of Transportation Act of 1966.

Written statements will be accepted at the meeting and for a period of 15 days after the public information meeting.
