The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet has scheduled a blank slate meeting for the proposed reconstruction of KY 57 from the Fleming/Lewis County line to the AA Highway in Tollesboro, Kentucky. This meeting will be an open house format, meaning that interested parties may attend any time within the two hours. There is no formal agenda nor presentation. This meeting is to gather information from the public and answer questions about the KY 57 roadway project. This will be the first of three (3) public meetings. The goal of the KY 57 project is to enhance the roadway to meet the future traffic demands while improving safety for all modes of transportation. Anyone having an interest in this project is welcome to attend.

The public meeting will run from 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM, Tuesday, February 12, 2019 at the Tollesboro Elementary School Gymnasium. Transportation Cabinet representatives and their consultant, Gresham Smith will be available to receive comments and respond to questions.

Both written and oral statements will be accepted at the meeting. A tape recorder will be made available for those who desire to make oral statements, and a comment sheet will be distributed to make it more convenient to provide written comments. Written statements will be accepted at the meeting and for a period of 15 days after the Public Information Meeting. Written statements should be addressed to Rachel Catchings, P.E., Kentucky Department of Highways, District 9 Office, P.O. Box 347, Flemingsburg, KY 41041, or returned using the postage-paid envelope provided with the comment sheet. All recorded and written statements will become part of the official record. Once compiled, the meeting record will be made available for review and copying after an Open Records Request has been received and approved.
