Kentucky Transportation Cabinet representatives are conducting a public information meeting at the Thomas Nelson High School in Nelson County on Thursday, September 27, 2018. Doors will be open from 5 pm until 7 pm.

The project examines the need for and types of improvements necessary to improve accessibility and connectivity to the west of Bardstown and reduce congestion downtown. The Kentucky Transportation Cabinet will use your input to evaluate alternatives that have been developed since the April 2018 public meeting. The meeting will be highly interactive with information presented for each alternative along with the opportunity to provide input. Representatives from the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet as well as the consultant will be available to answer questions. Written comments will be accepted during the meeting and up to 15 days after the meeting at the District Four Office.

Written comments from this meeting will become part of the official record for the project. Once compiled, the meeting record will be available for review and copy only after an Open Records Request has been received and approved.
