


- 1 IN SITUATIONS WHERE A THROUGH LANE BECOMES A MANDATORY EXIT LANE, A WIDE WHITE DOTTED LANE LINE SHALL BE INSTALLED.
- (2) 12" WIDE SOLID CHANNELIZATION LINE.
- 3 GORE AREA CHEVRON MARKINGS SHALL BE USED IN LANE DROP SCENARIOS AND WHERE AN INTERSTATE OR PARKWAY SPLITS. SEE TPM-204 FOR DETAILS ON GORE AREA CHEVRON MARKINGS.
- 4 LANE USE ARROWS MAY BE USED WHEN THERE IS AN OPTION LANE. A MINIMUM OF THREE ARROWS PER LANE SHOULD BE PLACED AS SHOWN AND SPACED AT APPROXIMATELY $\frac{1}{4}$ MILE.
- (5) DOTTED LANE LINES SHOULD EXTEND BACK AN APPROXIMATE DISTANCE OF 1/2 MILE FROM THE THEORETICAL GORE.
