### About this Write Up

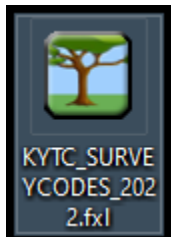

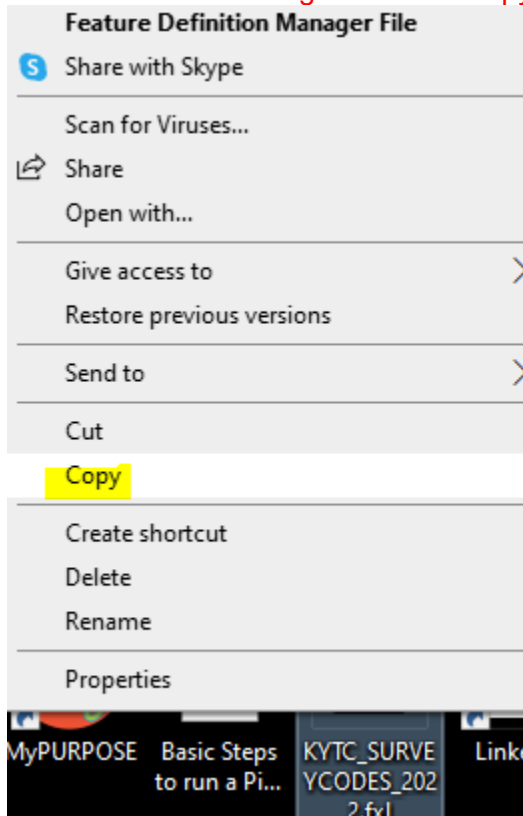

### .FXL File Storage

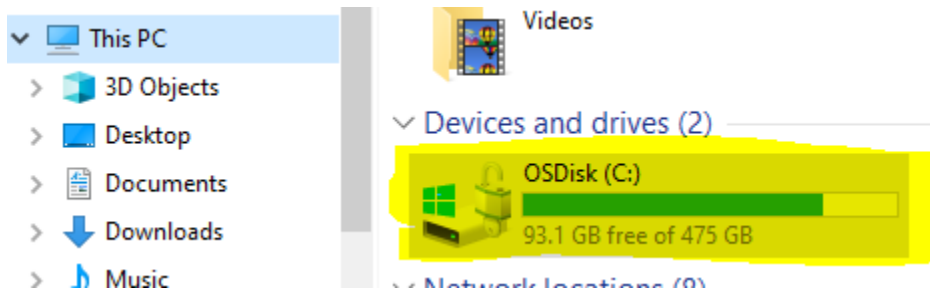
Here is your .FXL file that houses all of your Feature codes that KYTC recognizes.



You will next want to **right click** and **copy** the file.



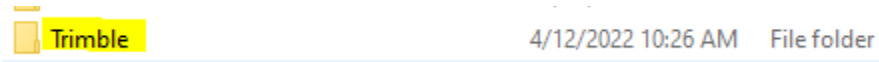
Once you have the copy filed you will want to open Windows Explorer and **navigate to the C:drive on your controller.**



Now that you have your C:Drive open, navigate to the **Program Data folder on your controller.** (Please keep in mind if you do not see this folder, you may have to turn on show hidden files).



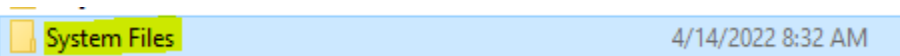
Next open the **Trimble folder.**



Next open the **Trimble Data folder.**



Next open the **System Files folder.**



Then you can **right click** (or CTRL+V) and **paste** it anywhere inside of this system files folder.
