Trimble TSCe Field Device: Connecting to a GPS Receiver Using Bluetooth Wireless Technology

Summary

When the Trimble[®] TSCeTM field device is fitted with a BlueCap[®] adaptor, the field device can connect to a Bluetooth-enabled GPS receiver, such as a GPS Pathfinder[®] Pro series or Trimble Survey R8/5800 receiver, using Bluetooth[®] wireless technology. This Support Note explains how to establish a Bluetooth wireless connection between one of these receivers and the Trimble TSCe field device

Connecting the handheld to the GPS receiver

Note: Before beginning, make sure the BlueCap adaptor is fitted to the TSCe field device.

To connect the Trimble TSCe field device to a Bluetooth-enabled GPS receiver:

- 1. On the field device, turn on the Bluetooth radio and scan for devices:
 - a. Tap Start / Settings / Control.
 - b. Tap the Bluetooth icon. The *Bluetooth Device Management* dialog appears.
 - c. Select the *Enable Bluetooth* checkbox.
- 2. Scan for other Bluetooth-enabled devices:
 - a. Tap **Scan**.
 - b. From the *Untrusted* list, select the device you want to connect to and then tap the right arrow button to move the device to the *Trusted* list.
 - c. When prompted to authenticate this device, tap **No**.

Tip: By default, authentication is not necessary when connecting to any Trimble receiver.

3. From the *Trusted* list, double-tap the GPS receiver you want to connect to and then select *Active*. A red check mark indicates that the receiver is now active and can be selected in your field software.

4. Configure the field software (for example, the TerraSync™ software or the GPS Controller software) to connect to the selected GPS receiver.

Note: To connect to a supported GPS receiver using a Trimble TSCe field device with a BlueCap adaptor, you require Revision B of the BlueCap adaptor and either TerraSync software version 2.51 or later, or GPS Controller software version 2.02 or later.

- a. Start the field software.
- b. From the dropdown menu, select the *Setup* section.
- c. Tap GPS settings.
- d. From the GPS Receiver Port dropdown list, select COM 7: Blue Cap.
- e. Tap **OK**.

The connection symbol appears in the status bar while the connection is made.

When the connection is successful, the satellite icon appears in the status bar.

You need at least four satellites to obtain GPS positions from the receiver.
