# **TRAFFIC SAFETY CHECKPOINTS: PLANNING AND OPERATIONS**

This course is for Kentucky law enforcement officers who have a role in traffic enforcement and DUI deterrence. It will provide officers with the knowledge and skills required to plan and conduct a safe, constitutionally sound traffic safety checkpoint. Topics covered include the effectiveness of checkpoints, implementation issues, Kentucky case law related to traffic safety checkpoints (including the required elements for a legal checkpoint), dealing with logistical issues such as staffing, costs and supplies, and safety for officers and motorists. **This course has been approved for 8 hours of continuing education credit by the Kentucky Law Enforcement Council (KLEC). There is no tuition fee or other charge for this course.**

This course is particularly appropriate for supervisors and agency administrators (e.g., ranks from sergeant through chief / sheriff) and officers who may be assigned to plan or supervise traffic safety checkpoints, but registration is open to all Kentucky peace officers and highway safety personnel.

Participants should bring an ANSI/ISEA-approved traffic safety vest to class. This class includes an outdoor, practical skills component. Casual clothing is acceptable for class, but participants should dress appropriately for the weather.
