How long is the law enforcement phlebotomy program?

The training consists of 2 weeks of classroom training and approximately 1 week of clinicals at a local hospital.

Where in the state is the training offered?

The training is conducted in Lexington through the KY Health Care Training Center.

What expenses does the state grant cover?

The state grant pays for student lodging, per diem, tuition cost, all necessary equipment, and exam costs.
