Greenup-Boyd Riverport Asphalt Loading Facility \$93,122.50

This project will provide asphalt surfacing on the last remaining section of a roadway connection from Port Road to an unloading facility on the water.





Owensboro Riverport Scale Access Improvement \$105,826

This project involves replacing the 25 year old port scale in a new location in an effort to relieve congestion and improve safety. Relocating the existing scale is not practical due to it's age and condition.

Eddyville Riverport
Port Road Widening
\$18,000

This project involves a 3' road widening for the port's main access road. The additional width will achieve an approximate 25' total width and allow truck traffic to stay on the asphalt





Hickman-Fulton Riverport Port Road Access Improvement \$15,000

This project will provide trucks with an alternative access road at the east end of the port, helping to alleviate truck congestion on KY 94.





Louisville-Jefferson Riverport Railroad Rehab #3 \$55,555

This project involves replacing 1,000 deteriorated crossties in an effort to maintain reliability of the track.

Replacing the ties will significantly improve the reliability of the track and maintain rail access.





Eddyville Riverport Asphalt Overlay \$16,500

This project will provide an asphalt overlay on a portion of one of the port's interior roads. This project will alleviate rutting and cracking and will allow trucks to travel with less obstruction.

Owensboro Riverport Grain Access Improvement \$83,650

This project will provide an 7.5" asphalt pavement on the port's interior grain access road. This project provides a better location for grain truck traffic and increases traffic flow and safety.





Henderson County Riverport Road Paving Project \$25,000

This project will provide pavement on the port's secondary entrance road, which will improve access to the truck scales and a warehouse used to store food grade packaging materials.





Eddyville Riverport Conveyor Access Maintenance \$10,664.48

This project occurred as a result of emergency repairs needed for the riverport conveyor. The repairs were the result of a head roller seizing up, causing the conveyor to be out of service.





Hickman-Fulton Riverport Port Road Access Improvement \$142,100

This project will provide pavement on the roadway accessing the Cargill grain facility. The current road is cracking and rutting due to years of truck traffic during harvest season.
