The purchase of a new material handler, skid-steer, and backhoe would greatly benefit our small riverport by enhancing barge offloading capabilities and movement of materials through the riverport. The new material handler replaces an older unit that has reached the end of its useful life, providing efficient, safe handling of bulk materials for faster barge unloading. The skid-steer is also used in final offloading of barges. The backhoe will serve in cleanup of materials dock-side and lighter loading of materials.

The skid-steer also offers versatility for cleanup of offloaded materials, easily navigating tight spaces to clear debris and clean dock areas. The backhoe is ideal for more intensive tasks and large volume cleanup as wells as lighter loading of materials from dock-side to truck. Together, this equipment would improve operational efficiency, safety, and productivity.

Introduction and Background

The Greenup-Boyd County Riverport is a critical piece of the Greenup and Boyd County transportation infrastructure and serves as a regional port facility supporting the economic growth of all neighboring counties. To enhance operational efficiency, meet growing demands, and ensure the continued safety and continuity of service, the facility needs to update and improve the ability to offload barges and deal with offloaded goods. This acquisition of new equipment will streamline off-loading and handling, reduce the need for manual labor and increase handling capacity for the materials handled at this port facility while allowing for a greater diversity of handled materials.

Objective

The objective of this project is to procure and install various material handling machinery that meets the operational needs of the riverport. The machinery must be capable of handling bulk goods and aggregates commonly off-loaded, provide reliability and durability in a riverport environment, and comply with all relevant safety and environmental standards.

Scope of Work

This SOW outlines the tasks and responsibilities for the supplier in the procurement and delivery of the required machinery. The successful bidder shall:

- Provide machinery that meets the functional and technical specifications as outlined.
 - Ensure all equipment is fully operational and compliant with applicable safety regulations.
 - Deliver machinery to the site and install where necessary within the agreed timeframe.
 - Provide training for riverport personnel on safe and effective use of the machinery if needed.
 - Offer maintenance support and warranty as per terms agreed upon in the contract.

Equipment Specifications

The required machinery will include:

- **Material Handler:** Capable of handling up to 4 cubic yards of bulk material of various types without exceeding maximum safe work load.
- **Skid-Steer:** For use in on-barge cleanup of remnant materials. Will serve additional capacity in maintenance of the riverport and should include both forks and broom attachments for this purpose.
- **Backhoe:** Will serve as cleanup of unloaded materials from barges that are not immediately moved to trucks and assist with dock-side tasks to facilitate the movement of goods including loading of lighter goods.

Each piece of equipment must:

- Be compatible with the various aggregates and materials commonly handled at the riverport.
 - Have a proven track record of reliability in industrial/port environments.
 - Include safety features compliant with OSHA standards.

Timeline

The proposed timeline for the procurement and delivery of equipment is as follows:

- **Contract Award:** 12/30/2024
- **Project Planning and Equipment Specification Finalization:** 1/15/2025
- **Delivery of Equipment:** No Later than 6/1/2025

Any delays or adjustments to this schedule should be communicated and agreed upon by both parties. Equipment delivery may occur at different times for each piece of equipment depending on availability in current stock.

Budget

The allocated budget for this procurement, including equipment, delivery, and training, shall not exceed \$1,500,000.00. Any expenses exceeding the budget require prior approval from the appointed board of the Greenup-Boyd County Riverport.

- Conformance with all technical specifications.
 - Successful demonstration of each equipment's functionality.
 - Approval by the Riverport Board based on recommendations from field experts.

Scope of Work: Greenup-Boyd County Riverport Material Handling Replacement & Improvements

To enhance operational capacity and efficiency, the Greenup-Boyd County Riverport seeks to acquire a skid-steer, material handler, and backhoe tailored for material handling in a riverport environment. This project is equipment procurement alone with no construction components.

The material handler will support the port's heavy-duty operations, including transferring bulk and aggregate materials from barge to truck. The minimum reach, lifting capacity, and appropriate attachments have been specified by the stevedores. Additionally, an elevated cab will ensure visibility. The total cost of this equipment is projected at \$1,098,177.86.

The skid-steer will provide versatile, compact handling for tasks such as loading, unloading, and debris clearing. It requires a minimum lifting capacity, compatibility with common attachments such as bucket, forks, and power broom, and essential safety features like Rollover Protection (ROPS) and high visibility aids. The total Cost of this equipment is projected at \$90,031.50.

The backhoe will be multi-functional, excavating and transporting materials around the port as well as cleanup and maintenance operations. Required specifications include a 24" bucket with thumb, ROPS, and compatibility with extra attachments for various dock-side tasks. The total cost of this equipment is projected at \$172,591.82.

The running total of expected equipment purchases are \$1,360,801.18 which exceeds the total sum allocated for the 2024 KPRCM program. The remaining funds will be requested from the 2025 allocation for that program. Equipment will be procured where possible through the KYTC master agreement and bid where not covered by that agreement. An additional administrative fee of 4% will be charged for the preparation of the application, supporting documents, procurement, negotiation, site planning, environmental, consulting, and any other services needed as a part of this project as specified under Eligible Costs. The total projected cost is \$1,425,801.18.

The project includes finalizing specifications, procuring and inspecting equipment, and delivering on-site training to riverport staff where required. Upon delivery, each machine will undergo inspection and operational testing. Documentation, including user manuals and maintenance guides, will be provided to ensure efficient operation and upkeep. The project is expected to be completed within the following timeline: contract award by January 1, 2025, specification finalization by February 1, 2025, equipment delivery no later than June 1, 2025, and in full operation by June 30, 2025.

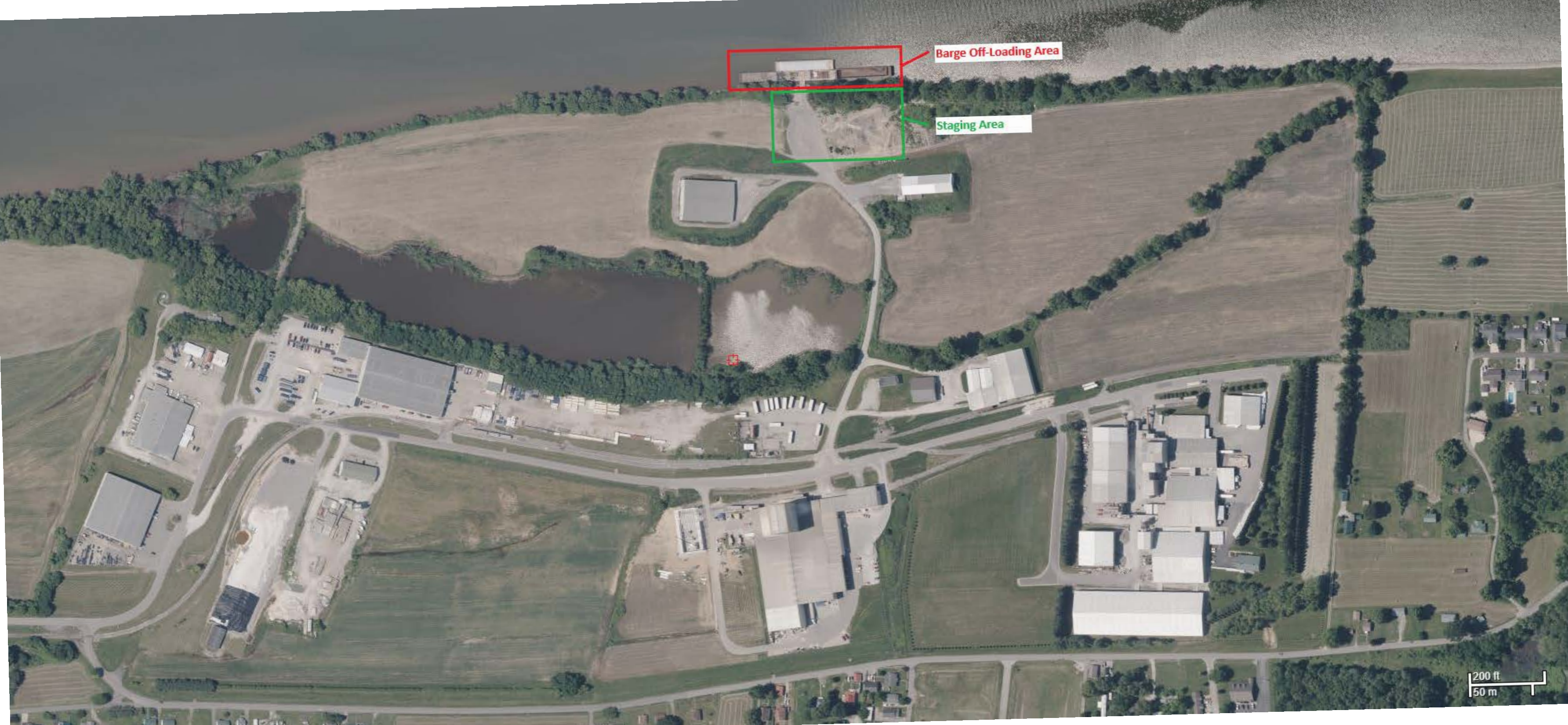
