  - New: Ladders of opportunity



#### (Very) Brief History

- The Water Transportation Advisory Board (WTAB) was established in 2010 to advise the Transportation Cabinet, the Cabinet for Economic Development, the Governor's Office, and the General Assembly on matters relating to water transportation.
- KY Riverport Improvement (KRI) Funds were enacted in 2012 and again in 2014 by the General Assembly in the amount of \$500,000 in dollar-fordollar matching funds for FYs 2013, 2014, 2015, and 2016.
- Legislation requires funds be used for dredging or maintenance of access.







# Summary of 2013 and 2014 KRI Projects Approved by WTAB and KYTC

#### 2013

- 3 Dock Repairs, including new concrete and structural reinforcement
- 3 Railroad Rehabs, including tie, ballast, and switch replacement
- 2 Roadway Asphalt Surfacing, including riverport entrances and terminal access road
- 1 Barge Access Catwalk
- 1 Conveyor Rehab and Maintenance

#### 2014

- 3 Railroad Rehabs, including tie and ballast replacement
- 3 Roadway Asphalt Surfacing, including riverport entrances and terminal access road
- 2 Grain Elevator Ramp Rehabs, including new concrete along the ramps and turn-out
- 1 Truck Scale Access Improvement
- 1 Barge Access Catwalk
- 1 Security Gate Addition
- 1 Dock Dredging











# Lessons Learned from 2013 and 2014 Projects Approved by WTAB and KYTC

- 1. Funds will lapse at the end of the Fiscal Year if they are not paid out.
- 2. Request awarded funds immediately after project is approved.
- 3. Project closeout documentation must include:
  - 1. Advertisement for bids
  - 2. Bid proposals including detailed scope of work
  - 3. Receipts and proof of payment
  - 4. Letter to KYTC certifying project scope and cost have been met

Owensboro Riverport Scale Access Improvement 50% Match Request: \$105,826

This project involves replacing the 25 year old port scale in a new location in an effort to relieve congestion and improve safety. Relocating the existing scale is not practical due to it's age and condition.











Eddyville Riverport Port Road Widening 50% Match Request: \$18,000

This project involves a 3' road widening for the port's main access road. The additional width will achieve an approximate 25' total width and allow truck traffic to stay on the asphalt









Eddyville Riverport
Asphalt Overlay
50% Match Request: \$16,500

This project will provide an asphalt overlay on a portion of one of the port's interior roads. This project will alleviate rutting and cracking and will allow trucks to travel with less obstruction.










Hickman-Fulton Riverport
Port Road Access Improvement
50% Match Request: \$15,000

This project will provide trucks with an alternative access road at the east end of the port, helping to alleviate truck congestion on KY 94.









Greenup-Boyd Riverport
Asphalt Loading Facility
50% Match Request: \$93,122.50

This project will provide asphalt surfacing on the last remaining section of a roadway connection from Port Road to an unloading facility on the water.









Louisville-Jefferson Riverport Railroad Rehab #3 50% Match Request: \$55,555

This project involves replacing 1,000 deteriorated crossties in an effort to maintain reliability of the track.

Replacing the ties will significantly improve the reliability of the track and maintain rail access.
