### History of the Kentucky Ag Development Fund

- Est. April 26, 2000 with 50% of Kentucky's Master Settlement Agreement (MSA) Funds
- Administered by the Kentucky Agricultural Development Board (KADB)
- Staffed by the Governor's Office of Agricultural Policy (GOAP)
- Investment funds to an array of county, regional & state projects designed to increase net farm income & create sustainable business enterprises



### **Investment Philosophy**

The KADB will make investments in innovative proposals that:

- Increase net farm income;
- Impact tobacco farmers, tobacco-impacted communities and agriculture across the state;
- Stimulate markets for Kentucky's agricultural products;
- Find new ways to add value to Kentucky's agricultural products;

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### Summary of By-Laws Amendment #1

- Substitute "Board" for all instances of "Authority"
- Limit officer terms to 2 years (previously no term limit)
- Add option for Board members to send Proxy voter from member's own membership class, for an individual meeting, representing...
  - Public Riverports,
  - Kentucky Association of Riverports, or
  - Private sector waterway industry at-large.

- Applications due MAY 1
- Include list of proposed projects (5-year outlook)
  - Riverport or City/County comp plans
- \*NEW\* KYTC in-depth project review with individual awardees
  - KYTC PreQualified Contractors
  - Bid Packet, Request for Proposals/Quotes, and Advertisement
    - Should include KYTC affidavits

# KY Riverport Improvement Program Sample Guidance Updates

- Notice to Proceed with Advertisement
- Signed Affidavits and Permits must be submitted to KYTC before grant funds are paid out
- Awardees must have a contractor selected and agree to MOA within 9 months of NOTICE of award

### KY Riverport Improvement Program Sample Project Scoring Elements

Scoring Elements	Max Points	Score
Project is included in Riverport or City/County Comp Plan	10	
Project is urgent to Riverport's current operation	10	
Application shows comprehensive preparation of project budget, scope, permits required, etc.	10	
Enhances Kentucky's Economy	10	
Past performance in compliance with KRI Program* (FY 19)	10	
Total	50
