

## **Public Engagement**

Stakeholder and public engagement is a core component of the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet's (KYTC) project development process, including the I-65 Bridge Bundling Project—branded locally as the I-65 Central Corridor Project.

To ensure proactive and transparent communication throughout the planning and construction phases, KYTC has implemented a comprehensive communications coordination strategy. This strategy is guided by KYTC's standard procedures and a Public Involvement Plan tailored specifically for this project.

The project's communications team includes representatives from KYTC's Office of Public Affairs, the Public Information Officer and leadership from the Kentucky Department of Highways District 5, consulting teams (design, project management, construction oversight), and public involvement specialists from C2 Strategic Communications.

Over the past 19 months, KYTC has conducted more than two dozen in-person meetings with Tier 1 stakeholders—including city officials, planners, and representatives from major healthcare, education, business, transportation, tourism, and utility sectors. These meetings have served to both inform stakeholders about the project and gather input on how construction may impact the community and their organizations.

Stakeholder feedback has been incorporated into project planning, design, and construction scheduling to help minimize disruptions to travelers, businesses, and organizations.

## Strong Local Support

Prior to this outreach, KYTC engaged key stakeholders and elected officials to inform them about the project and its associated request for a major grant through the federal Bridge Improvement Program. The decision on this grant is pending.

## Informational Materials

Project updates and information are available on the official project website to keep the public informed. During construction, the site will also provide details on lane closures, traffic management, and a corridor map with information on each of the 18 bridges.

In summer 2025, dedicated social media channels will launch to share project news, construction updates, and traffic alerts. Stakeholders will also receive updates via email and text alerts.

Upcoming outreach efforts include:

- Public announcement of construction start and planned interstate closure in summer 2026
- Launch of dedicated social media channels, newsletter and text messaging service
- Media engagement, including regular updates on project plans, preliminary construction, mitigation efforts (ramp expansions in Watterson Expressway, etc.)
- Pop-up informational events with key stakeholders
- Stakeholders communications kits to extend project messaging
- Potential use of traditional and digital advertising during construction

The Public Involvement Plan will be regularly updated to enhance outreach effectiveness and ensure continued public understanding and support throughout the Louisville area.
