### **Project Description**

The Eddyville Riverport is a critical logistics hub serving western Kentucky's agricultural, industrial, and river-based freight sectors. Port Authority Road is the sole access point to the port, supporting heavy truck traffic year-round, particularly during the harvest season. Due to years of wear, exposure to weather, and inadequate design for modern truck volumes, the road has deteriorated significantly leading to safety concerns, traffic bottlenecks, and maintenance challenges.

From a market perspective, the project supports regional supply chains and enhances the port's competitiveness in attracting new business and cargo volume. Improved infrastructure will help existing tenants expand operations and will strengthen the region's case for industrial recruitment.

Increased efficiency and reduced transportation delays will directly benefit local businesses and agricultural producers, while the improved infrastructure will support job retention and create new opportunities related to construction, port logistics, and industrial development. As activity at the riverport grows, the enhanced road access will be a foundational asset in supporting long-term job creation and economic growth in the region.

### Statement of Work

The Eddyville Riverport is accessible solely via Port Authority Road, a dead-end route that terminates at the port. Over the years, we have conducted patchwork repairs to keep the road serviceable. However, the pavement has significantly deteriorated and now requires a full asphalt overlay to ensure safety and efficiency for industrial traffic.

This project will reconstruct and resurface approximately 4,500 feet of Port Authority Road, widen the entrance at KY Hwy 93 for safer truck turning movements, and add gravel shoulders to improve vehicle maneuverability and reduce edge damage. These improvements address a clear operational need by ensuring reliable, safe, and efficient access for commercial carriers, contractors, and agricultural producers.

#### Scope of Work

This project involves the complete resurfacing of approximately 4,500 linear feet of Port Authority Road, extending from its intersection with KY Hwy 93 to the gates of the Eddyville Riverport. The work will include laying a new asphalt overlay using a high-durability polymer surface treatment commonly applied on interstate highways, which will significantly extend the life of the pavement. As part of the improvements, the entrance to the road at KY Hwy 93 will be widened to improve the turning radius for commercial trucks, thereby enhancing safety and traffic flow. Due to the existing guardrail at the port entrance,



incoming trucks turning right into the port must swing wide to avoid contact. This causes outbound trucks to shift onto loose gravel shoulders to allow passage. These conditions hinder safe and efficient two-way traffic. The proposed improvements will directly address these safety and operational challenges. The project also includes the addition of two-foot gravel shoulders along both sides of the road to provide more room for maneuvering and to reduce edge deterioration. Special attention will be given to resurfacing the section of the road located beneath the I-24 bridge, where water and ice melt from the overpass have led to severe erosion of the existing surface due to constant exposure and heavy truck traffic.

### **Project Authority**

Although Port Authority Road is currently owned and maintained by the City of Eddyville, the City has formally granted the Eddyville Riverport Authority permission to assume responsibility for its maintenance and pursue funding for necessary improvements. A letter of support from the Mayor of Eddyville is included with this application, confirming the City's approval for the Riverport Authority to oversee and execute the proposed road upgrades.

### **Project Schedule**

Pending funding approval, construction is scheduled to begin in July and conclude in early August. This timeline is designed to ensure completion prior to the region's agricultural harvest season, which sees a substantial increase in truck traffic to and from the riverport.

### **Long Term Planning**

This project is a key component of the Eddyville Riverport Authority's long-term infrastructure improvement plan, which prioritizes reliable, safe, and efficient access to the port to support ongoing industrial growth and regional commerce. Improving Port Authority Road has been identified in our strategic planning documents as critical to maintaining the competitiveness and operational capacity of the riverport, especially given the increasing volume of inbound and outbound freight traffic.

The Riverport Authority has budgeted funds to execute the project without delay and we are fully prepared to meet the financial match requirements. The match will come from the Riverport's general fund. This readiness reflects our strong commitment to investing in the long-term sustainability of the riverport and its supporting infrastructure.



### Proposed Growth Projects

### Riverport

The following figure shows the existing riverport survey. The riverport has 274.5 contiguous acres with approximately 225 acres currently wooded.



Currently 33 acres are developed with water access and utilities (water, gas and power). Of the 33 Acres, 8.9 acres are currently under Tennant Lease. ERIDA is currently under contract with a Kentucky Riverport Improvement Grant to construct Sheet Piling Seawall at the boat lift well to mitigate erosion and improve shore access.






Proposed Projects / Development in the first 5 years. Key projects are proposed to address road infrastructure, utility infrastructure, and operational capacity.






