Statement of Work

The Riverport, with the purchase of the material handler through the KPRCM grant, will transition the unloading and loading of bulk materials to our 2nd dock, previously the scrap and coal dock. The surface outside of the immediate dock area is stone. The purpose of this grant is to construct a 3,025 s.f. pad 12" deep with rebar mats. This will provide a hard durable surface to allow semi-truck access and allow for efficient and environmentally safe cleanup of spillage. Opening this dock up to bulk unloading will provide Henderson County Riverport Authority with the ability to double our handling capacity, create 3 to 5 skilled labor jobs and save our customers' demurrage costs charged by the barge lines for delays in loading and unloading barges.

Scope of Work / Project Cost Estimate:

Replace existing stone staging area with a 3,025 s.f. pad.

Work to include:

Mobilization and Travel

Layout and excavate to 16" below finish grade.

Compact the existing subgrade.

Furnish and put in place 4" of DGA rock and compact.

Form and set up an area approximately 2,550 s.f. and pour in 2 different pours.

Furnish #5 rebar and tie into place @ 12" on center, each way, top and bottom.

Furnish and pour 4,500 psi, 28-day mis, at 12" deep.

Furnish a pump truck, to properly place concrete.

Finish with bull float and broom finish.

Wreck the forms and backfill, with existing spoils.

Layout and saw control joints where needed.

The project cost estimate is \$95,590.00.

- -Furnish a pump truck, to get concrete in place.
- -Finish with a bull float and broom Finish.
- -Wreck the forms and backfill, with existing spoils.
- -Layout and saw control joints, where they are needed.
