Any loss or damage prior thereto will be at Sellers risk.
- 4. WARRANTY STATEMENT The Seller, ATLAS-SSI, Inc., warrants to the original purchaser only, each new and unused product of its manufacturing to be free from defects in material and workmanship for the "Warranty Period" specified in the proposal. The Warranty Period will begin after delivery of the equipment to the original purchaser. If, within the Warranty Period, Seller received written notice promptly after the discovery of any defect in the material or workmanship in the equipment Seller shall remedy each such defect at Seller's option, either by (1) making available F.O.B.
