This device will increase efficiency when loading or unloading aluminum sow/tbar/ingot with our material handler crane to/from a barge. The material handler crane is an effective backup to our harbor crane for this operation, giving valuable redundancy to our overall operation and customer base. The Rotator will allow positioning of the lifting pan both inside the barge and on the dock to streamline the handling of product in a safe manner.
