As our business continues to grow, we are experiencing an increased demand for operational efficiency. To meet this demand Owensboro Riverport is seeking financial support for resurfacing and exit road extension.

The ORA resurfacing and exit road extension project is a necessary project to maintain existing asphalt and provide a more efficient existing of trucks from the Warehouse 4 and guard check in. The portion of the project specific to Warehouse 4 truck staging area is in needed repair originally paved in 2003. 


