Louisville Metro Government (LMG) Fleet

- Total vehicles in LMG Fleet = approximately 2,500
- Currently...
 - 2 CNG garbage trucks
 - 3 BEV/PHEV
 - 40 Hybrid Vehicles
 - 15 Propane Zero Turn Mowers
- Future...
 - Adding approximately 6 additional Propane Zero Turn Mowers
 - Add 10 (possibly) PHEVs
