Hopkinsville Driver Licensing Regional Office Operating from Alternate Location While Permanent Office Undergoes Storm Damage Repairs

Licensing services offered by appointment only

FRANKFORT, Ky. (July 1, 2024) – The Hopkinsville Driver Licensing Regional Office at 901-A S. Main St. is currently closed for repairs due to storm damage from an early June severe weather event. A temporary alternate location in Hopkinsville is in operation to serve Kentuckians by appointment only until further notice.

Weekday office hours at the temporary location are Monday through Friday, 8 a.m.-4 p.m., and appointment holders will be notified of the address. The temporary location will be open Saturday, July 13, 8-11:30 a.m., for **walk-in customers only**.

On June 3, 2024, a severe thunderstorm passed through Western Kentucky, dropping approximately 11 inches of rain at the Main Street location, causing considerable damage. The temporary closing is necessary for cleaning and rebuilding. Repairs are expected to be complete by September.
