This form is used by agri-chemical businesses to obtain a restricted commercial driver license (CDL). The CDL is valid for 60, 120, or 180 days. The applicant for the restricted CDL completes Sections 1 and 2, and 3. The employer, or agri-chemical business, completes Section 4.

After the applicant has submitted a completed TC 94-32, Commercial Driver License Application, the TC 94-169, Commercial Driver License Self-Certification, and a valid TC 94-157, Medical Examiner's Certificate Card to the Division of Driver Licensing, CDL Section, the applicant can take the completed form to the Circuit Court Clerk's office in the county of residence.
