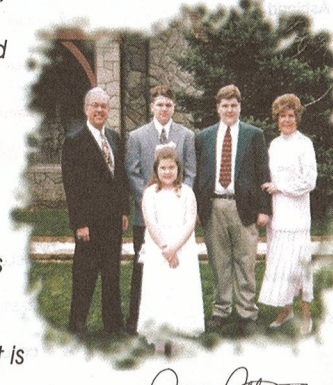


Dear Traveler:

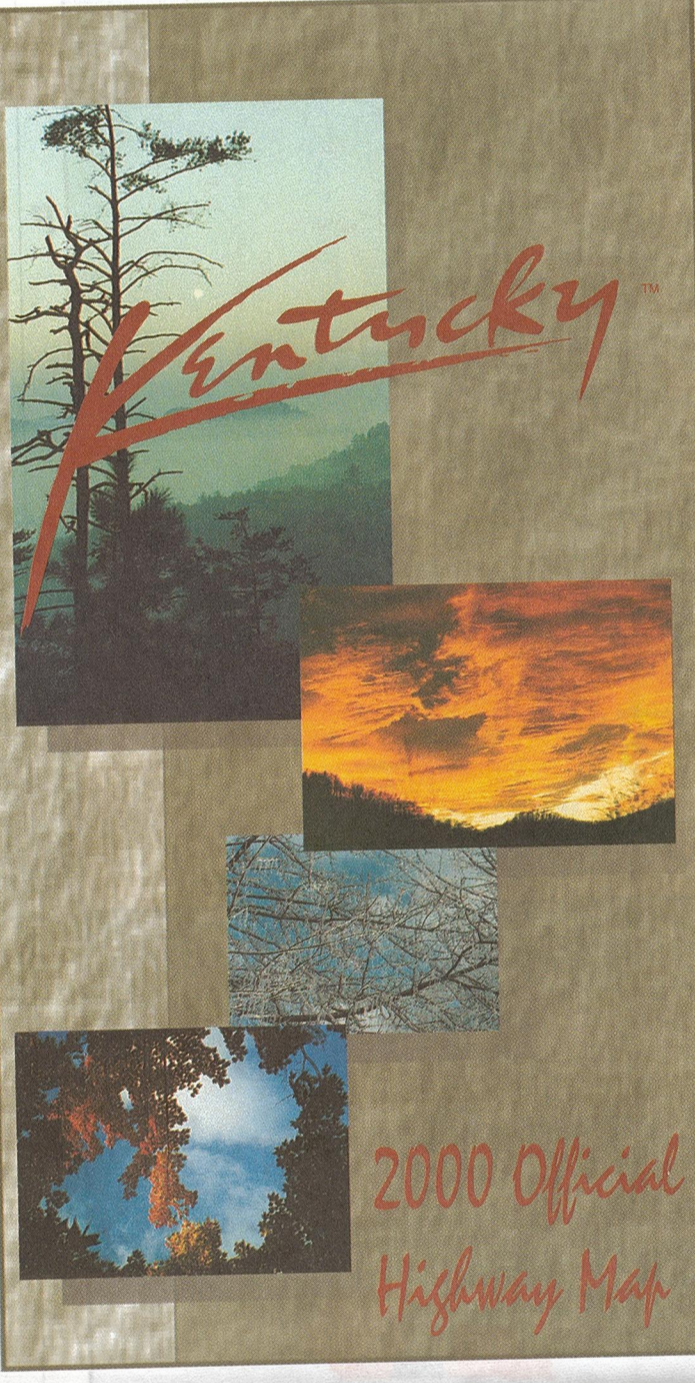

Drive Smart Kentucky
 For Current Conditions of Interstates, Parkways and Major Routes, Call 1-800-4KY-ROAD

Speed Limit - 65 mph on rural sections of Kentucky's interstates and on most parkways. Other roads as posted.
Seat Belts - Kentucky has a mandatory seat belt law, so please buckle up!
Child Restraints - Federally approved child restraint seats are required by Kentucky law for all children 40 inches tall or less.
Turning - Kentucky has a right turn on red law, unless an intersection sign states otherwise.
Driving Under the Influence - Please, for your safety and the safety of others, don't drink and drive. If convicted of D.U.I., first time offenders can expect a 90-day license suspension, fines of \$200 - \$500, and possible jail time up to 30 days. Penalties are more severe for second and subsequent convictions.
Accidents - If you are involved in an accident, notify the nearest state police post or use the emergency number listed below. Accidents not investigated by the police involving personal injury or property damage of \$500 or more must be reported by the individual to the Justice Cabinet within 10 days. Official forms are available from any police department of state police officer.
