BACKGROUND

Third Rock Consultants, LLC (Third Rock) was retained by QK4 to develop a planning-level “red flags” environmental overview to consist of a compilation and presentation of environmental data that may affect the design, development, and implementation of any proposed improvements. This Technical Memorandum (TM) documents the methodology and results of Third Rock’s assessment of known underground storage tank (UST) and/or hazardous materials (HazMat) sites that represent potential design and construction constraints. For purposes of this TM, “search area” is defined as a one and a quarter mile radius of Butler, Kentucky, through which KY-177 is currently aligned.

METHODOLOGY

Environmental Data Resources, Inc. (EDR) was contracted to conduct an electronic search of publicly available historical topographic mapping and aerial imagery and a variety of applicable environmental databases, including those pursuant to ASTM standards, for sites within the search area. A summary of the EDR findings is included in **Appendix A**.

EDR findings were reviewed and evaluated for their relevance to the KY-177 corridor based upon listing status, location, and position in relation to the planning study area. A subsequent windshield survey was conducted November 9, 2023, to field verify the existence and location of EDR-reported sites, as well as unreported UST and/or HazMat sites visible from publicly available roadways and property (see Photo Log, **Appendix B**).

FINDINGS

EDR Regulatory Records

Sites listed in **Table I**, page 2, are located within, or adjacent to, the study area and represent red flags due to the likely presence of USTs and/or hazardous materials.

Historical Mapping

The aerial imagery and mapping identified in **Table 2** were reviewed to assess the historical use of the study area and immediately adjacent properties.

The earliest topographic mapping available (1929) reveals 12 structures north of the Licking River bridge along the current KY-177 corridor and numerous structures were observed in the City of Butler between the Licking River and the L&N Railroad. The 1952 aerial imagery and 1953 topographic mapping revealed the construction of the current KY-177 alignment across the Licking River, along with sparse commercial facilities. The City of Butler, as well as the surrounding rural land use, appears to have predominantly remained the same since the 1950s, aside from increased residential density.

Kentucky Geological Survey (KGS) water well mapping revealed numerous plugged monitoring wells located at Northern Elementary. These monitoring wells represent a red flag due to the suspected former presence of USTs.

Site Reconnaissance

During site reconnaissance, the location and condition of the four (4) EDR Regulatory Records sites identified in **Table 1** were field-verified. Five (5) additional sites were observed within, or adjacent to, the study area that represent red flags due to likely presence of USTs and/or hazardous materials as summarized in **Table 3**, page 3. See *also* Photo Log, **Appendix B**.

CONCLUSIONS

Ten UST and/or HazMat sites were identified as potential red flags as a result of the assessment: four (4) from EDR's Regulatory Records search, one (1) from KGS water well mapping, and five (5) identified during site reconnaissance as summarized in **Table 4** and illustrated on **Exhibit I**, page 5.


