




MINORITY POPULATIONS


LOW INCOME POPULATIONS


ELDERLY POPULATIONS

Block Group 1 CT 501 (33%) has a higher Limited English population than the counties, the state and the country. Block Group 2 CT 501 (3.8%) has a higher Limited English population than the state but less than the country. Block Group 1 CT 532(7.9%) has a higher Limited English population than the country.
