FY21 Omnibus Appropriations Bill

• Enacted into law on December 27, 2020





Full Year Obligation Limitation - \$46.4 B

- PLUS \$2 B General Funds for Highway Infrastructure Programs
- \$1.08 B New Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Program.
 - Minimum of \$6 M per state!
 - Maximum of \$60 M per state!
 - Based on Bridge Condition TPM

What did we get?

General Operating Expenses – \$475.6 M

- Increase of \$22.1 M
- Immediate cancellation of hiring slow down
- FHWA-KY will be hiring a new planner
