QUESTION 1

Do we have to go through a pre-qualified right-of-way acquisition firm to get an appraiser for the Kenton County, KY 16 project, Item No. 6-344.00? If not, how do we need to identify the appraiser in our proposal?

ANSWER 1

The response does not need to identify the appraiser in the proposal. At the time that the right-of-way acquisition work starts, the prime consultant shall request approval of an appraiser from the Department's approved list. Currently, we do not pre-qualify right-of-way acquisition firms.

QUESTION 2

Can we use the effected utility company to do our utility relocation estimate? If not, how do we identify this person in our proposal?

ANSWER 2

The response does not need to identify the individual who will do the utility relocation estimate. The firm and/or individual performing the work will be approved by the Department prior to the work.

QUESTION 3

The stretch of KY 16 just south of Item No. 6-344.00's beginning point is also horrible-is this section being designed by the District or a consultant at this time? If so, which and who?

ANSWER 3

The Six Year Plan does not identify additional sections of KY 16 for design work.
