PURPOSE AND NEED	Correcting structural and geometric deficiencies of KY 56 to allow it to be added to the National Truck Network and classified as a "AAA Trucking Route". Trucks now entering Union County from Illinois have to travel on KY 109 to Sturgis and take US 60 to get to Morganfield which is economic detriment to Union County.
