The structure design will be performed by the Department. Prequalification in the area of structure design is required to be identified in the consultants Response to Announcement.</i>

5. *Consultant's Kentucky office where work is to be performed. (2 points)*

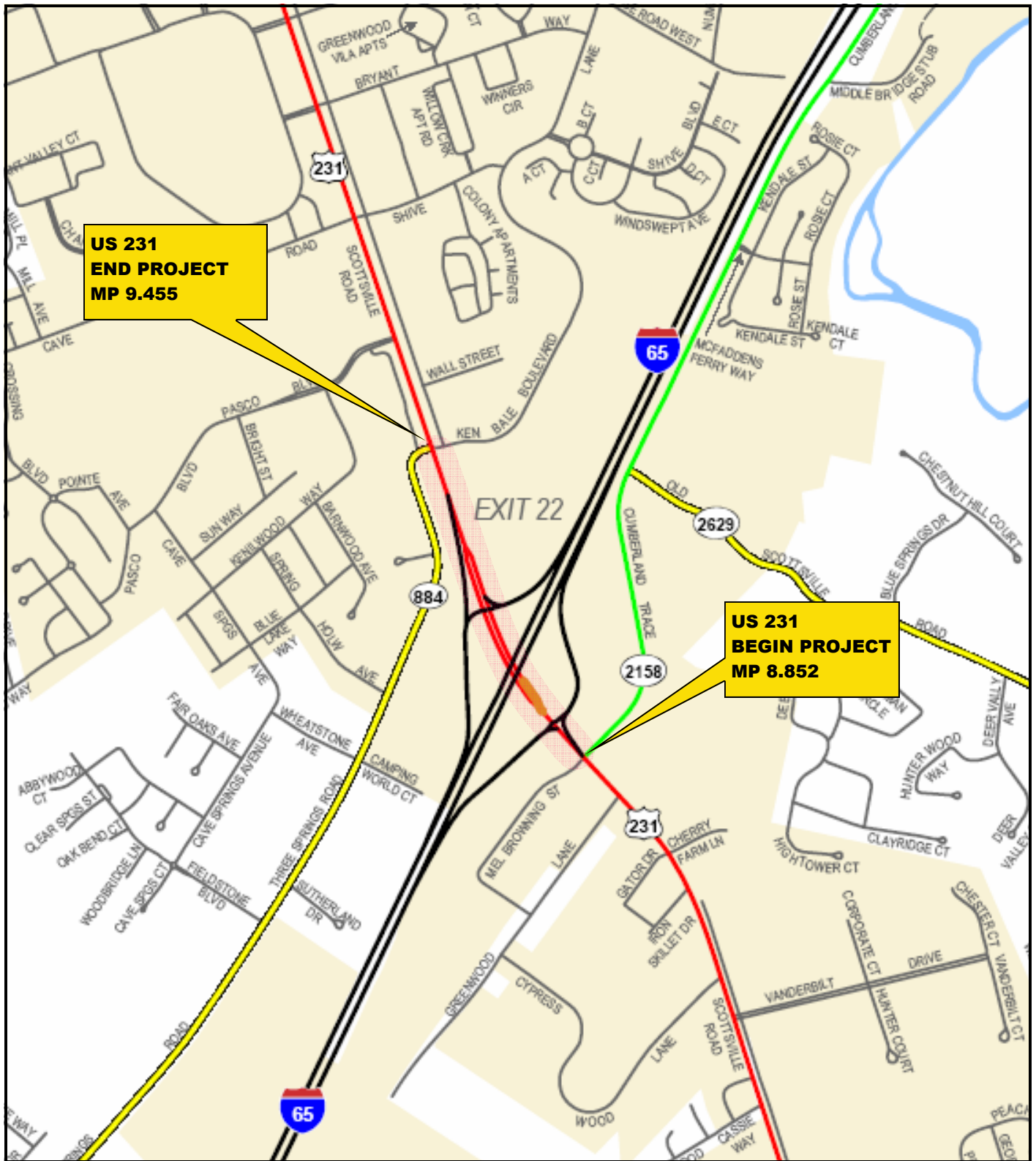
