Within the project limits, 2006 traffic volumes were found at 2271 and 2295. The purpose of this project is to improve safety by targeting inconsistencies and deficiencies within the project limits and upgrading as necessary to meet current design standards.

### SCOPE OF WORK

The Selected Consultant will be responsible to identify a range of potential improvement options. This work is anticipated to include developing an inventory of existing problems and corresponding solutions, as well as prioritization of segments according to need and cost estimates. The Selected Consultant will be responsible for Phase I Roadway Design, including; intermediate surveying, design studies, design alternative, cost estimates, and recommended alignment. The Selected Consultant will also be responsible for Phase II Roadway Design including; development of any design studies, drainage design, right-of-way plans, construction plans, traffic control plans, cost estimates, and final plans. The Selected Consultant will also be required to provide Engineering Services to perform Structure Design.

### SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

The project limits for this project encompass <u>Carter Co. Item No. 9-8506.00</u> (Replace two (2) bridges and their approaches on KY 773 between MP 1.0 and MP 1.3.), so the Consultant should anticipate some coordination with another design firm. Item No. 9-8506.00 is approximately 0.30 miles in length, including two (2) bridges and the roadway between them. Two (2) projects have been included in this contract for Design Services due to their proximity.

The Department may retain any of the services advertised here to perform in-house. Phase II Roadway Design and Structure Design Services may be added to the Contract Agreement by Contract Modification.
