PURPOSE AND NEED	The existing structure is a 40' Single Span Concrete RCDG beam bridge with asphalt overlay and WSM abutments with concrete caps. The structure has a sufficiency rating of 37.5 and a posted weight limit of 10 tons. Due to the substandard structural conditions, in addition to a substandard horizontal alignment, the bridge requires replacement.

The Selected Consultant will be required to provide Engineering Services to perform Phase II Roadway Design; including the preparation of any design studies, drainage design, right-of-way plans, construction plans, traffic control plans, and cost estimates.

For state funded projects, if a selection committee vote results in a tie between two (2) firms, one (1) of which will perform more of the work tasks in Kentucky than the other, then the former firm shall be ranked one (1) place ahead of the latter.
