PURPOSE AND NEED	The purpose of this project is to replace a bridge and its approaches on CR 1283 between MP 7.4 and MP 7.5 over Tygarts Creek. County funds are used annually to remove debris and prevent scour created by a center pier located in the creek. The project is necessary to replace one (1) single-lane bridge which is geometrically and functionally deficient. In addition, the bridge has been assessed a sufficiency rating of 41.9. CR 1283 is a Rural Local Collector with ADT of 192.
