# II. PROJECT INFORMATION

#### III. PURPOSE AND NEED

Purpose: The purpose of this project is to improve the safety, the geometrics, and the connectivity between Central Kentucky and many communities and rural areas of Southeastern Kentucky, and to improve highway performance along this corridor to facilitate Economic Development.

Needs: The ramp(s) at the Mtn. Parkway/KY 7 interchange provide access to and from the Parkway for Traffic in the Salyersville area. The ramp geometry does not meet recommended 30 MPH Design Standards.

The intersection of the Mtn. Parkway and US 460 has a history of rear-end collisions.

The Mtn. Parkway provides a vital connection between Central KY and many communities and rural areas of Southeastern KY.

Please refer to the attached DNA study for identified safety concerns.

#### V. SCOPE OF WORK

Conduct preliminary engineering studies to identify appropriate typical section, line and grade, utility impacts, dependable cost estimate, and the preparation of exhibits necessary for the department's submittal of the appropriate environmental document. The environmental document at this time is expected to be Environmental Overview.

The selected Consultant will be required to provide engineering services to perform Phase II roadway design which will be added to the contract by contract modification when Phase I is complete. Phase II design will include the preparation of any design studies, drainage design, right of way plans, construction plans, traffic control plans and cost estimates.

The selected Consultant will be required to provide structure design services which may be added to the contract agreement by contract modification.
